New SPIN Funding Opportunities Database Now Available!

We are pleased to announce that the SPIN funding opportunities database is now available via the Research Management System (RMS). With over 40,000 opportunities from more than 10,000 sponsors, SPIN is a consolidated source for easily locating external funding opportunities using a variety of the following features:

- Search/filter using keywords, sponsor, location, etc.
- Set up personalized automatic funding alerts and track opportunities of interest
- Receive notifications of new funding opportunities
- Access curated lists of WashU managed internal selections
