The following verbiage was approved on 3/17/14 by William F. Tate, Dean, Graduate School of Arts & Sciences, Vice Provost for Graduate Education, Edward Mallinckrodt Distinguished University Professor in Arts & Sciences.

The Dean of the Graduate School of Arts & Sciences and Vice Provost for Graduate Education distributes a notification to Arts & Sciences departments strongly encouraging the Directors of Graduate Studies and Department Chairs to support graduate student participation in the MyIDP program (<http://myidp.sciencecareers.org/>). In addition, during new graduate student orientation, the Dean or a designee provides a brief overview of the MyIDP program to entering doctoral students and master's degree candidates in science and engineering.
